Introduction

As we gather tonight, we have begun the Season of Advent, a Season of waiting and preparing for the Lord.

Is there something you are waiting for this Advent? If so, have you been waiting for a long time?

I made to the house of Israel and the house of Judah.

In those days, at that time,

I will make a just shoot spring up for David; he shall do what is right and just in the land.

In those days Judah shall be saved and Jerusalem shall dwell safely, this is the

name they shall call her:

"The LORD our justice."

Commentary: In those days. When will those days happen? Many of us find ourselves in chaotic situations because of health crises, or family broken relationships, or political unrest. We definitely need a savior. When will those days be fulfilled?





What practices help you stay focused on the Lord? What could you do this Advent to help you wait with joy for His coming?

The key to any situation in which we find ourselves waiting is to keep our focus on God. Yet it's all too easy to get distracted and sometimes even stray from thoughts about God.

Our world is full of distractions, and we often welcome them. But all too often, distractions take our eyes off the Lord. We start to turn to them to soothe our painful feelings rather than turning to God Himself. Then we risk losing our focus on the Lord and what He

is doing in the present moment. We also risk missing the opportunity He is giving us in these times of waiting to grow closer to Him.

Tonight, let's wait together.

Reading: Luke 21:34-36


